Peter Waldo - 1140-1218



Peter Waldo, a wealthy merchant of Lyons, amassed his fortune by lending money with interest. In about 1170, concerned for the welfare of his soul, he asked a priest to tell him the perfect way of attaining God. He was amazed to hear these words of Scripture: "If thou wilt be perfect, go sell what thou hast..." He had never heard this text before and soon undertook a serious study of Scripture. He turned over part of his property to his wife and daughters and the rest to the poor. Waldo took to the streets, proclaiming his deliverance from the bondage of money and preaching the gospel to all that would listen. Soon he had many followers. The Poor men of Lyons, or Waldensians, based their life on the Sermon on the Mount, embracing poverty and rejecting all violence. Waldo was eventually charged with heresy and excommunicated.
